As for the team, in the beginning of the race tire trouble occurred and we had no choice but to change one of our strategies. I was shocked at this trouble. Toshiki dared to bring the car back to the pit and continued the race. Due to such effort, we could collect data. I take this accident positively somehow.

We never gave up this race and moved up to 10th place and scored precious points in the end of the race with the help of other car's penalty. I would thank the team for their



perfect pit work and re-realized "nobody knows what will happen in the race."

I noticed there was an equal number of audiences before pandemic of coronavirus disease at Fuji today. Since I grabbed some clues for the next round, I would like to define them to fight for the top positions in the next round.
